Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Provide support with design, implementation, and maintenance of the VMware environment. Deploy and manage AWS solutions to include compute, storage, archive and backup and services. This will include day-to-day operational support of the existing VMware virtualized systems and infrastructure and the design and establishment of a Hybrid/Cloud architecture.
