- The Strategic Analyst shall support the development, review and update of tactical plans intended to implement the overall goals and objectives of the various NSWC Crane strategic plans.
- The Strategic Analyst shall provide program and planning support for the development of NSWC Crane business plans. Support shall include: developing and maintaining program/project plans, coordinating, and securing meeting requirements with attendees on/off site, providing synopses of meetings, developing and giving presentations, developing, and maintaining databases, establishing priorities and research and providing analysis reports, coordinating and providing data call responses, and evaluating and providing assessment of technical and nontechnical program reports.
- The Strategic Analyst shall prepare, review, revise, and maintain documents, including process, technical, quality, software and systems, operations, testing, and user documentation.
